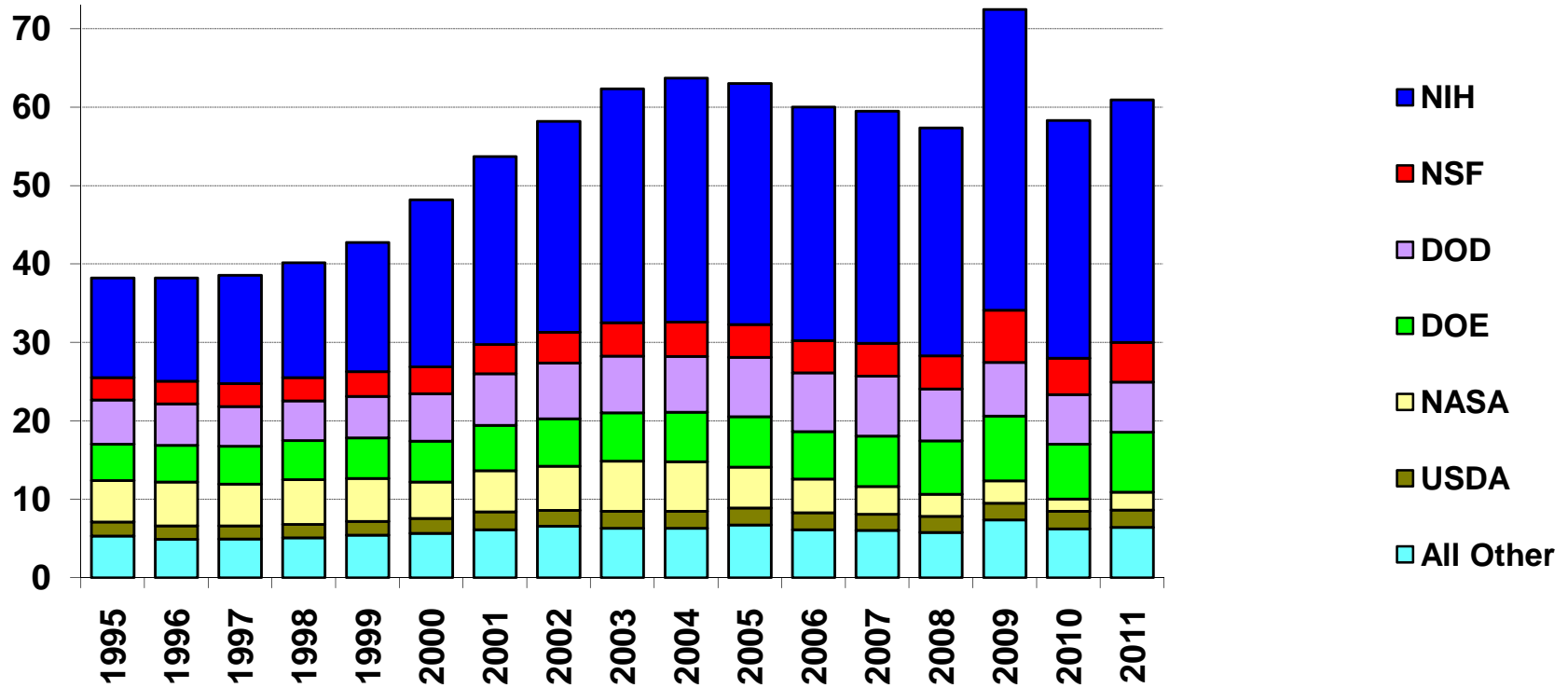

Trends in Research by Agency, FY 1995-2011

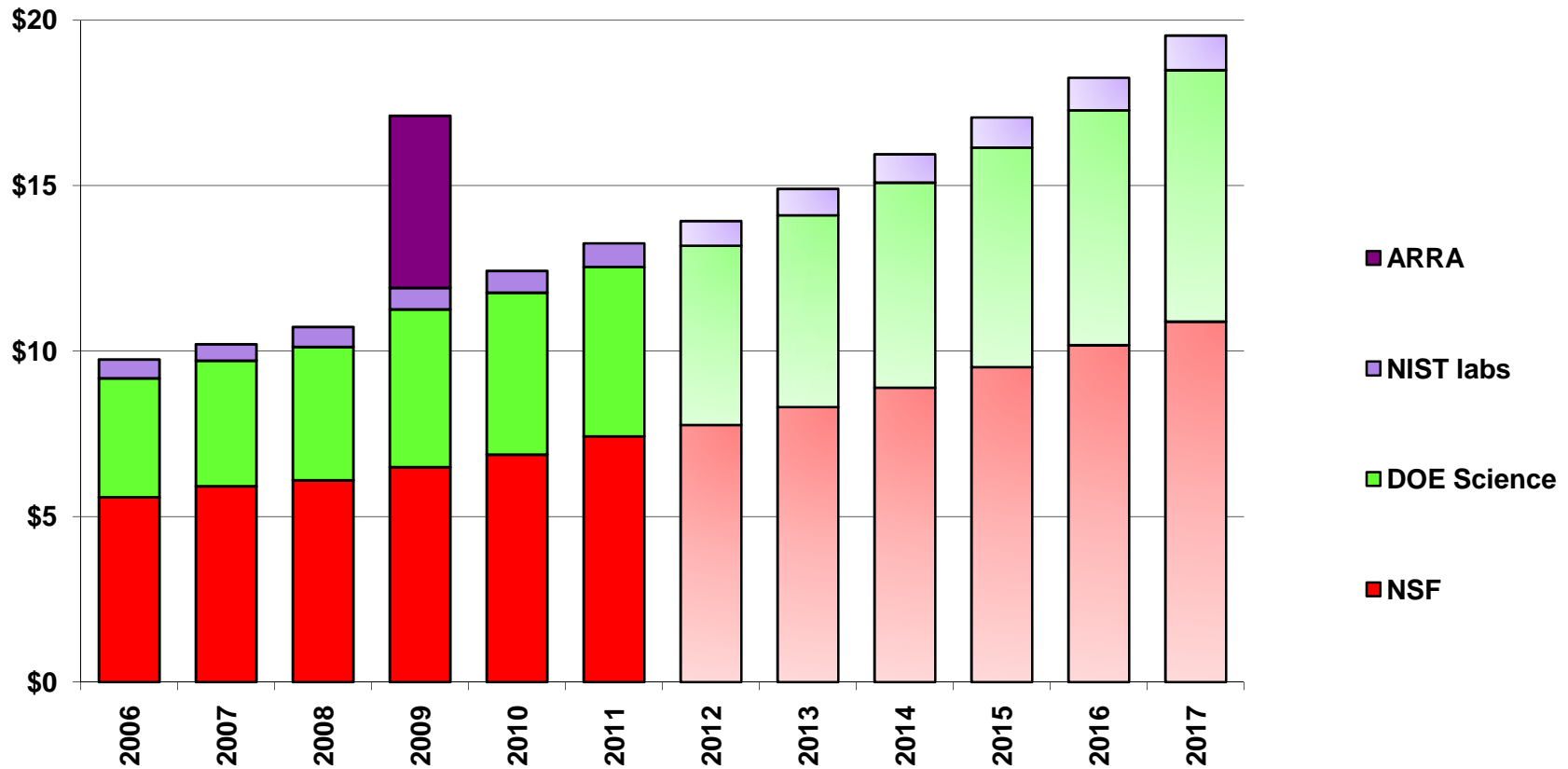
in billions of constant FY 2010 dollars

President's Plan for Science and Innovation, FY 2006-2017

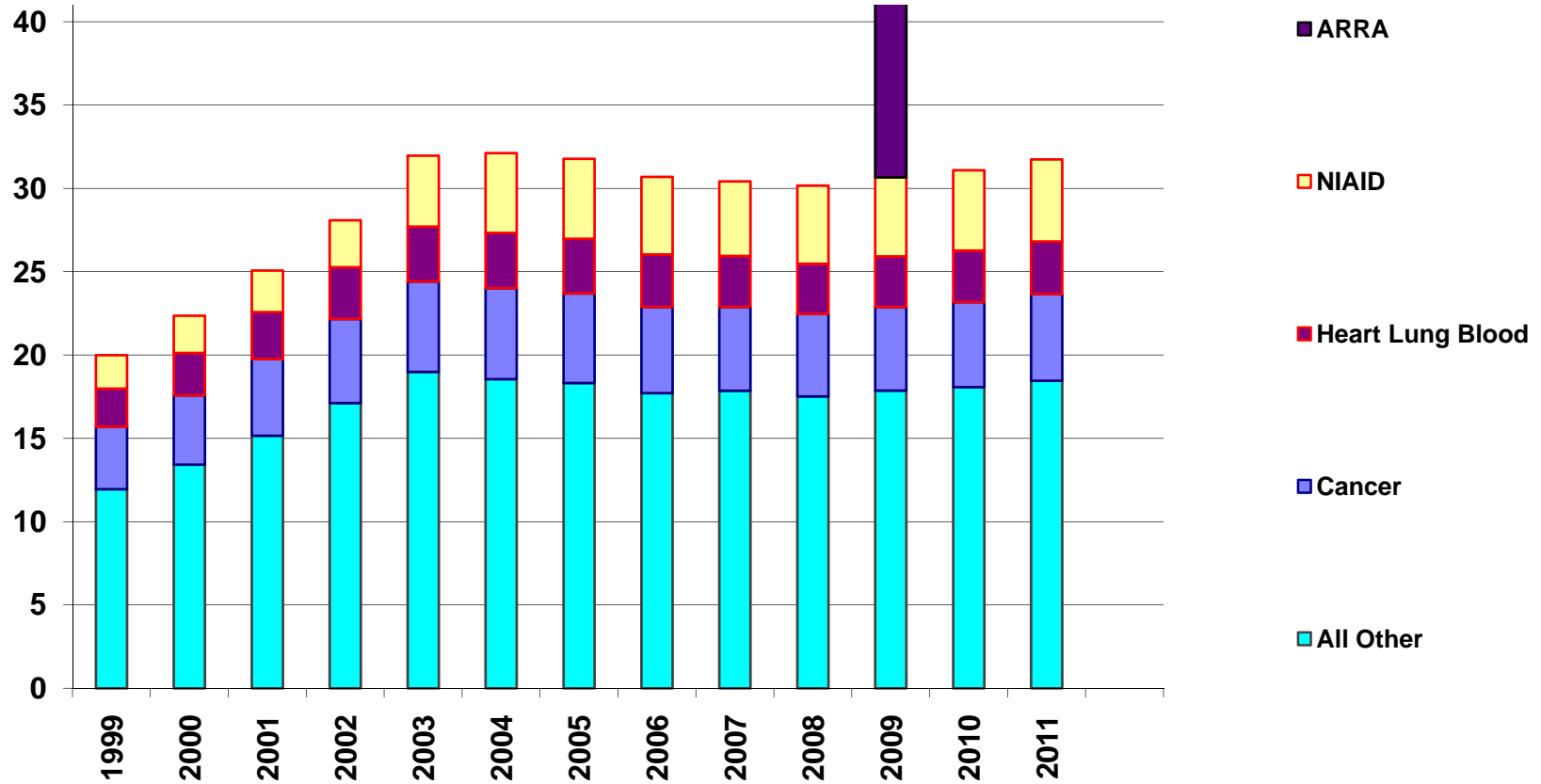
(budget authority in billions of current dollars)

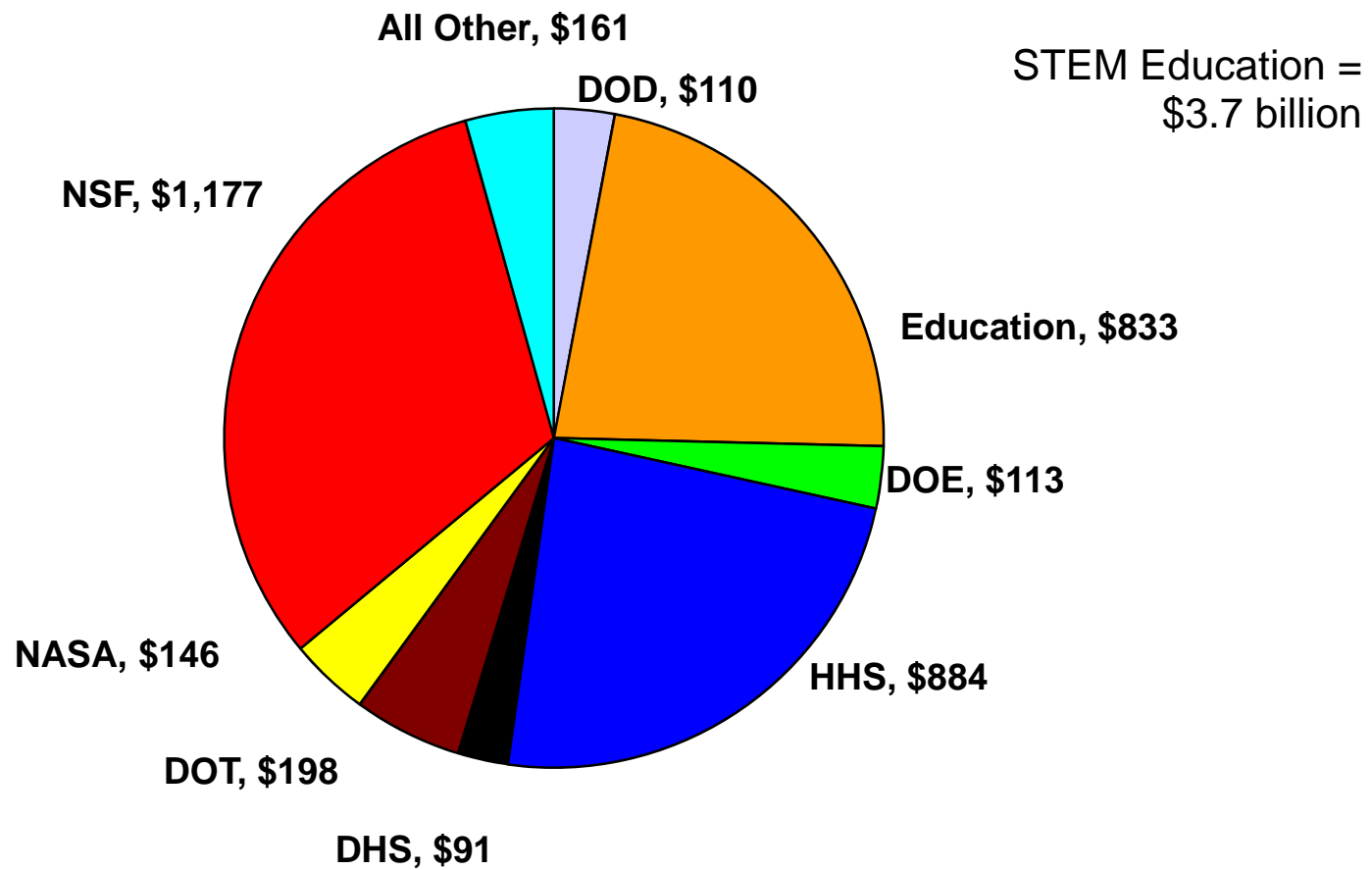
National Institutes of Health Budget with Select Institutes, 1999-2011
